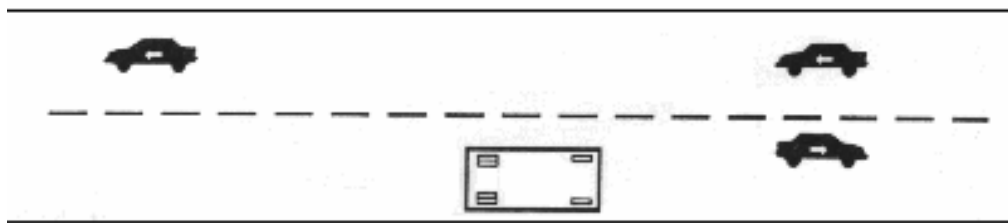

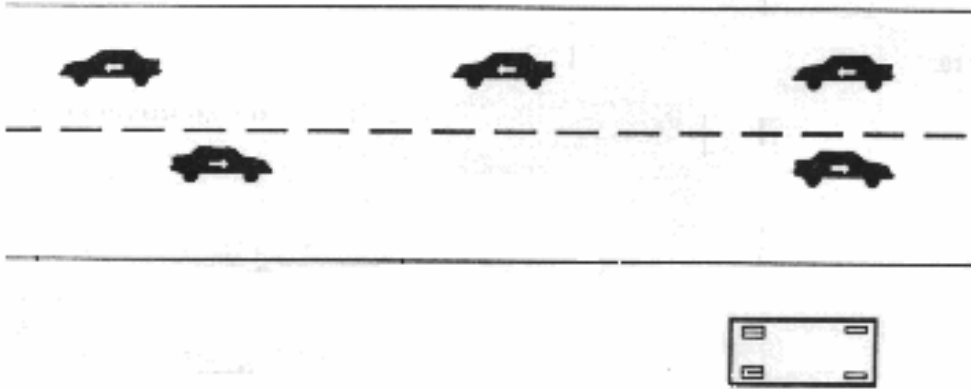

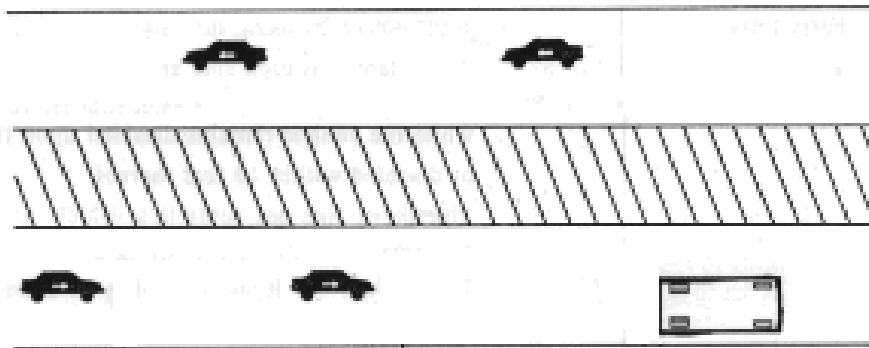

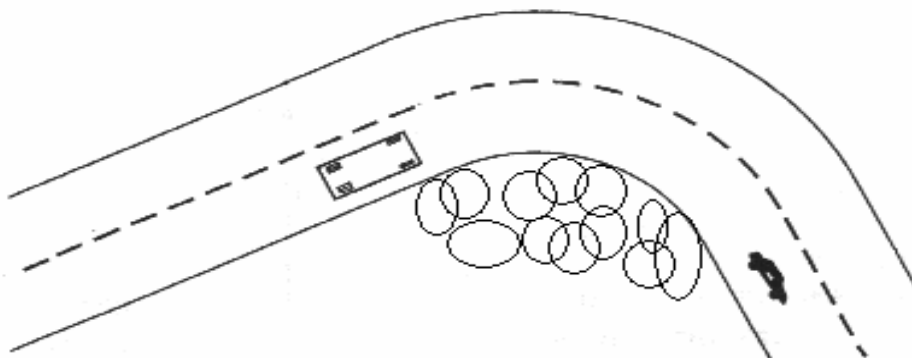
TWO LANE HIGHWAY
