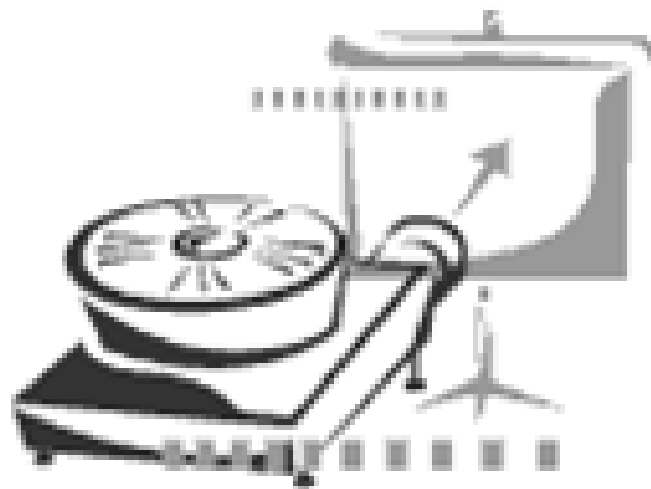

BUS JEOPARDY

Computer Instructions

This program was developed in Microsoft Office PowerPoint 2003. For this program to run properly you will need to reset the security in Macros: Find and open PowerPoint software program on your computer - go to Tools – Macro – Security and change from high security to medium or low – click ok.

Items Required

Projector
Lap Top Computer
Extension Cords
Bus Jeopardy Power Point Programs
Rewards
Goodie Bag
Timer
Horn

Separate drivers into 3 teams. 5 to 6 drivers on a team would be perfect however 8 – 10 works fine.

Do not let drivers pick their own teams.

Have them count off 1,2,3 and separate accordingly or hand out different color tickets.

Have each team pick a captain – this will be the individual who will give the official question/answer.

Ask for volunteer - one to keep time.

Time limit to answer = 60 seconds

Each group can discuss the possible question and then the captain has the choice to either accept their question or to go with his/her own. Allow the next team to steal the answer but do not penalize the team that got the answer wrong by subtracting points.

First game winners get to pick from the winners bag.

Break after the first game.

Winners of the 2nd game get to pick from the winner's bag.

All contestants get an opportunity to pick from the bag at the end of the program.

Depending on the ability and knowledge of the drivers this in-service usually take 2.0 – 2.5 hours to complete.
