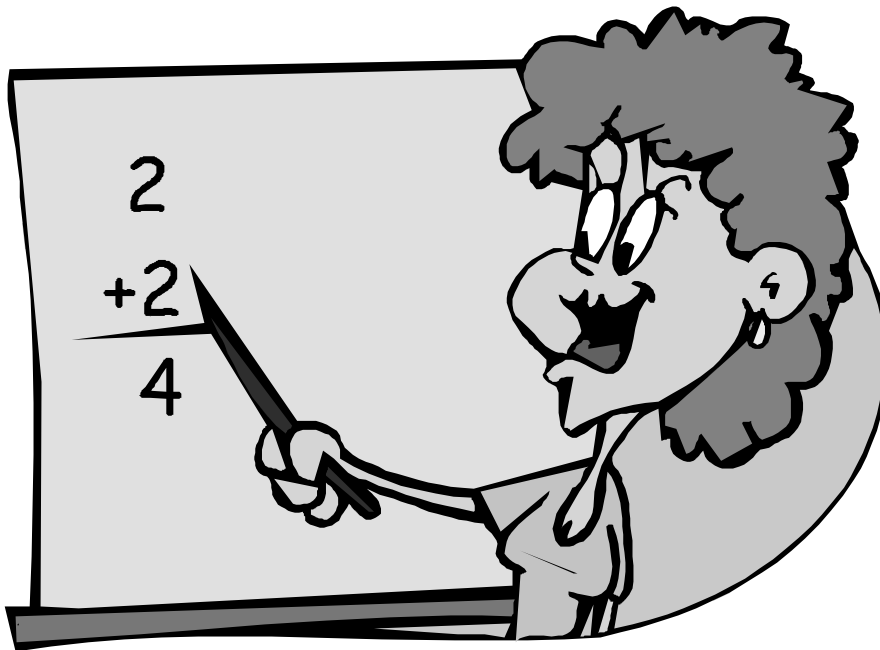

Separate drivers into teams. Depending on the number of drivers at the program will depend on the number of teams. 5 to 6 drivers on a team would be perfect however 8 – 10 works fine, 2 to 3 teams works the best - 4 teams is more difficult to keep their interest and attention.

Do not let drivers pick their own teams.

Have them count off 1,2,3 and separate accordingly or hand out different color tickets.

Have each team pick a captain – this will be the individual who will give the official question.

Start out with the 6 basic categories and one extra category for a total of 7.

Ask for volunteers – one to keep score and one to keep time.

Time limit to answer = 60 seconds

Each group can discuss the possible question and then the captain has the choice to either accept their question or to go with his/her own.

Allow the next team to steal the answer but do not penalize the team that got the answer wrong by subtracting points. It is much easier for the score keeper to only have to add points.

Instructors have a choice of which answer to give depending on the group and experience of the drivers. Make sure to keep track of which questions you have used by checking off or crossing off so not to repeat. Instructors also have the discretion to change to answer to a different category – some answers in the 50 point section could easily be in the 100 point section.

First game winners get to pick from the winners bag.

Break after the first game.

The break gives you time to fix the board for the next game and the winners an opportunity to look thru the winner's bag without taking up in-service time.

After the first game change the extra category with one of the three remaining categories not used.
